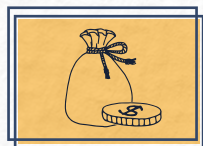
Key Activities Implemented:



Communication with potential partners for cooperation to the end of bringing best international expertise to the project at hand;

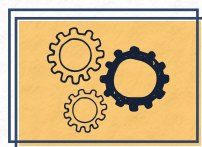


The short-term research project - Monitoring hate speech and extremist messages in the social media contributing to the polarisation of the society;

Deliver two training sessions to the CNCS members;

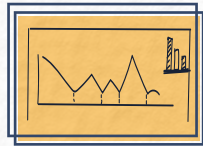


Designed Terms of Reference and announced a call for International Experts/Organisations to design a practical handbook on the best practices in P/CVE.

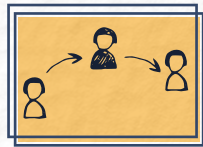
Capacity Building of the Training Centre of the State Security Service of Georgia (SSG)
